Carboniferous Beasties...

You will need:

Stiff card

Sticky tape

Coloured tissue paper

Double sided sticky tape

Bits and pieces for decoration

Garden wire to support the wings

20-50 cm plant stick, or similar stick



Step 1. Cut out two beastie body shapes from stiff black or coloured card. It should be about two thirds of the length of your stick.



Step 2. Decorate the body using whatever glitter, sequins, buttons or coloured paper you have.

Step 3. Cut out two sets of wing shapes from the tissue paper. Bend the wire into a similar shape.



Step 4. Stick the wire to the tissue paper using sticky tape, then glue

another wing shaped piece of tissue paper on top.

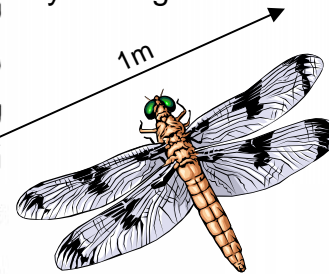
Step 5. Now stick the wire wings on to the body of the beastie and stick the garden stick along the body of the beastie, as shown in the picture.



Step 6. Stick the other body shape on top of the garden stick and wire wings using double sided sticky tape. Your Beastie is complete.

FACT! The carboniferous time was 300 - 350 million years ago.
