Easy Easter Eggs

You will need:

Eggs
Tissue paper in a variety of colours
Cling film



Step 1 Hard boil your eggs. To do this place the eggs in a pan and add enough water to just cover them. Heat the water on a hot hob and wait 10 minutes for the eggs to cook. Leave them to cool down once cooked.

Step 2 While the eggs are cooling down, tear up tissue paper into small pieces. These could be rough squares, strips or you could even cut them into circles or diamond shapes. Place the pieces onto the cling film.

Step 3 Wet your egg by rubbing it with a damp cloth and place it in the middle of the tissue paper pieces.



Step 4 Wrap the cling film around the egg, gently pressing the tissue papers against it. Leave it to dry for an hour.

Step 5 Remove the cling film and tissue paper and you will have a lovely colourful egg!

Easter Time

Easter occurs in the spring which is one of our 4 seasons here in Britain (the others are summer, autumn and winter).
