### Christmas Hand Wreath

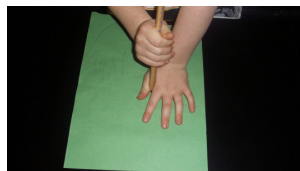
#### You will need:

- Green card or paper
- Paper plate
- Glue
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Glitter glue and sequins for decoration



**Step 1** Cut a circle out the middle of your paper plate, leaving just the bumpy outer part.

**Step 2** Draw around your hand on the green paper. Do this several times and cut them out. You will probably need between 10 - 15 cut-out hands.



**Step 3** Stick your cut-out hands on to the paper plate with the fingers to the outside.

**Step 4** Using the ribbon, tie a bow and glue it near the bottom of your wreath. Decorate with glitter glue and sequins.
