Our Commitment

- 1. To comply with Government legislation, environmental agenda's and targets set for the next 10 years.
- 2. To give all customers the chance to recycle their eligible waste materials throughout the building in line with Zero Waste Scotland's "Recycle on The Go" scheme.
- 3. To switch off all pc's, monitors, tills & photocopiers overnight.
- 4. We aim to reuse office equipment & furniture where appropriate around the building.
- 5. We aim to reduce the amount of waste paper in the building by favouring emails over letters & operating a paper amnesty.
- 6. We aim to recycle our waste food including from staff meals, the cafe and events.

How You Can Help...

- 1. Understand how your kerbside recycling collections work.
- 2. Where available, use public recycling bins and help keep the waste streams pure by putting the right waste in the correct bin
- 3. If you 'switch off' rather than using stand-by, you could save up to £40 a year.
- 4. There are a number of ways you can dispose of unwanted items without them going in the bin – visit www.reduceuserecycle.co.uk for ideas
- Did you know : Turning the tap off whilst brushing your teeth can save up to 8 gallons of drinking water.
- Each family uses about six trees worth of paper every year.
- 1 iron contains enough plastic to make 95 yoghurt pots and enough steel to make 13 steel cans
